A return to Westpoint Exhibition Centre in Exeter, now under new management. With up to 400 stands from all over the UK, offering an extensive range of Antiques & Collectables, the fair provides a great day out for people who love all things Antique. With dealers from all over the UK there will be a huge selection of Antiques & Collectables to include; Furniture, Porcelain, Silver, Gold, Jewellery, Glass, Textiles, Vintage Clothing, Paintings, Lighting, Militaria, Kitchenalia, Toys, Stamps, Collectables and much, much more.

FRIDAY 23 MARCH Departing Oxted we travel to Hungerford where we visit the Antiques Arcade in an ancient building in the centre of this historic Berkshire town. The Arcade has been trading for over 40 years and was one of the first antiques centres to be opened in this country. Laid out to resemble a street, with a series of walk in units and cabinets under its ancient beams, there are over 100 antiques dealers under one roof, with something to entice every visitor from pocket money collectors to lottery-winning big spenders. We travel on to Parade Antiques in Marlborough, with over 40 dealers in an attractive

Georgian building, then to Bradford on Avon a beautiful Cotswolds town with many antique shops. We arrive at our Bristol hotel early evening.





SATURDAY 24 MARCH This morning we make our way south to the Westpoint Exhibition Centre at Exeter. We have an optional midday visit to Topsham Quay on the banks of the River Exe where 70 dealers occupy 9000 sq. ft. on 3 floors, with jewellery, pictures, ephemera, textiles, porcelain and much more. We return to Bristol via the Trading Post Antiques Centre near Axminster.

SUNDAY 25 MARCH We seek out local Sunday village fairs, where so often bargains are to be found before returning home early evening.
